Proposition 2022—2—Changes in the Absent Voter Ballot Request Processes:


In November 2022, the voters of Michigan passed Proposal 2022-2. This proposal establishes new guidelines for obtaining an Absent Ballot. The Michigan Constitution now recognizes that residents, once registered to vote, may submit a ONE-TIME signed absent voter ballot application that covers ALL future elections.

The process of mailing an application for each election is being retired and will <u>no longer</u> be in effect after this year. Voters must sign up to receive a ballot automatically for each election held in the Township. You will not be placed on the new ballot list automatically. It is the voters responsibility to update the Township with:

- Any address changes (This is very critical if you move and for you to receive your ballot on time.).
- If you are out of town for an election and wish to have your ballot sent to you at an address other than your home address.
- If you are away for the winter (snow-bird) you must provide us with a mailing address and the dates of your departure and return.



Yes, I wish to be placed on the Permanent Voter <u>Ballot</u> List . I understand that I will receive an Absent Voter Ballot prior to every election as allowed under the passage of Proposal 2022-02.



No, I do not wish to be placed on the Permanent Absentee Voter Ballot List. I will request a Ballot for each election that I wish to vote as an absent Voter.
