### Board of Trustees

Workshop meetings are held at noon the first Monday of each month and regular meetings are held at 6:00 p.m. the first Monday of each month at the Township Hall.

4 year terms. Candidates must be a resident of the Township, collect a designated amount of Township resident petition signatures and run for office in a primary and a general election. Elected Board members receive an annual salary.

Board member positions include: Supervisor, Clerk, Treasurer and four Trustees

The Township offers elected officials the opportunity to learn core competencies and take part in other types of training through Michigan Township Association (MTA). Local treasurers and clerks in Berrien County have also formed associations which offer support and workshops specific to treasurers and clerk duties.
