

**RESOLUTION**

Moved by Mr. Smith and seconded by Mr. DeVries, that in conformance with and pursuant to action of this Board taken at its regular meeting of May 20, 1974, that the following Ordinance be and hereby is adopted to be utilized in conjunction with the present Building Ordinances of St. Joseph Township, the more restrictive provisions of the respective ordinances to apply in each case:

**ORDINANCE ADOPTING  
UNIFORM BUILDING CODE  
1973 EDITION**

An ordinance regulating the erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, moving, removal, conversion, demolition, occupancy, equipment, use, height, area and maintenance of buildings or structures in the Township of St. Joseph, providing penalties for the violation thereof, and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Trustees of the Township of St. Joseph as follows:

That the Uniform Building Code, 1973 edition, be and the same hereby is adopted to become effective on July 23, 1974, that being thirty (30) days from the date of publication of this ordinance. Said code being adopted by reference pursuant to the provisions of Act 250 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

Copies of the Uniform Building Code, 1973 edition, are to be kept in the office of the Township Clerk, available for inspection by and distribution to the public at all times and that a complete copy of said Code is available

for public use and inspection in the office of said Township Clerk.

The Building Inspector will have the duty to administer and enforce the provisions of the Code.

This ordinance will be published in The News Palladium on Saturday, June 22, 1974.
