**ORDINANCE NO.** 29

An ordinance to adopt by reference the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages.

The Township of St. Joseph ordains:

**Sec. 1. CODE ADOPTED**

The Uniform Traffic Code for cities, townships and villages promulgated by the Commissioner of State Police on February 14th, 1959 and published in Supplement No. 13, and as amended both on February 14th, 1961 and published in Supplement No. 25, and on February 26th, 1968 and published in Supplement No. 54, to the 1954 Michigan Administrative Code, in accordance with Public Act 62 of 1956, State of Michigan, is hereby adopted by reference as in this ordinance modified.

**Sec. 2. REFERENCES IN CODE**

References in the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages to "governmental unit" shall mean the Township of St. Joseph.

**Sec. 3. NOTICE TO BE PUBLISHED**

The Township Clerk shall publish this ordinance in the manner required by law and shall within ten (10) days publish a supplementary notice setting forth the purpose of the said Uniform Traffic Code and of the fact that complete copies of the Code are available at the office of the Clerk for inspection by and distribution to the public at all times.

**Sec. 4. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES REPEALED**

All other ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of the Uniform Traffic Code are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

**Sec. 5. WHEN EFFECTIVE**

The Uniform Traffic Code will be in effect in this governmental unit thirty (30) days after the publication of the supplementary notice as provided in Sec. 3 above.
